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### **BOAT YARD AND STORAGE SHED USAGE POLICY**

This policy sets out guidelines for the use of the NTWSA boat yard including the storage shed area and car parks.

The goal of this management is to provide a safe, functional area, to prevent overcrowding and obstacles to the use of member owned watercraft.

Proper management of these areas is required to satisfy the standards set by the NTWSA Committee for the prevention of injury to members and the general public. It also identifies controls and limits the risks associated with the storage of watercraft. It is also required to prevent expenses incurred to the Club for the problems associated with 'dumped' watercraft, containers, vehicles and other materials.

Policy points:

1. Any members applying for assets to be stored at the NTWSA premises must have the permission of the President and/or Committee member responsible for the management of the boat yard and boat shed area.
2. Users must be financial skiing members of the NTWSA.
3. The yard and sheds are intended for the storage of watercraft.
4. No liability will be accepted by the NTWSA for watercraft stored on site.
5. Vehicles cannot be stored unless they are dedicated 'tow' vehicles owned by the Club and/or its affiliate Clubs. Tow vehicles must be in working order and have appropriate registration for vehicle type.
6. All watercraft must be in working order and be mounted on a functioning trailer.
7. Only minor maintenance may be conducted on the Club's grounds. Spray painting, sanding, blasting or any other activities that may create a health hazard or contribute to noise pollution are not allowed.
8. Fuel containers must be secured at all times to prevent tampering.
9. Batteries must be secured inside the watercraft.
10. Owners are responsible for keeping their boat storage area and surrounds neat, tidy and clear of rubbish. A lawn mower is available.

11. Storage fees must be paid six months in advance. Invoices will be sent twice a year, in January and July.
12. The gate next to the refrigerated container must be kept clear at all times.
13. The gate to the boat yard must be kept locked and clear of all traffic at all times.
14. The boat wash down area must be kept clear of all traffic for the exclusive use of financial ski members.
15. The area directly in front of the boat sheds must be kept clear at all times. Any boat shed renters who display appropriate signage eg “Keep Clear at all times” on their boat shed have the approval of the NTWSA Committee to remove obstructing vehicles.
16. To maximise parking capacity, no long term storage of vehicles in the members’ car park is allowed.
17. Inside the NTWSA grounds the maximum speed limit is 5 km/h.
